Air & Waste Management Association (A&WMA) Gulf Coast Chapter Graduate Environmental Science and Engineering Scholarship

Application for Entering, Currently Enrolled, and Transfer Graduate Students

A&WMA is an independent, non-profit organization that raises and manages private gifts to benefit and promote environmental studies.

A&WMA Gulf Coast Chapter Graduate Environmental Science and Engineering Scholarship was created to provide scholarships to Graduate students who are interested in pursuing a career in an environmental engineering, environmental science, or a related field.

Eligibility

All graduate students admitted to a university in the State of Texas, who maintain satisfactory academic and research progress, and pursue a degree toward Environmental Engineering, Environmental Science, or a related degree are eligible.

Selection Criteria

All of the following selection criteria must be met to be considered by A&WMA:

- Student Major must be Environmental Engineering, Environmental Science, Geology, Chemistry, or another environmentally related major;
- Student must be enrolling as a new student, or enrolled as current student or transfer student in the Fall of 2020;
- Student must have taken the GRE or an equivalent exam;
- Student must be enrolled/enrolling for a minimum of 9 hours and maintain this fulltime status throughout the semester and subsequent semesters;
- The cumulative grade point average (GPA) for current students and transfer students must be at least 3.00;
- Student must demonstrate leadership and participation in student, civic or professional organizations, and take an active role in their communities; and
- Student must have an interest in pursuing a career in the environmental engineering and science or related field.



Application Procedure

Application Package:

Application package for Graduate Students must include:

- A completed application form, signed, and dated. The form must be named **Lastname_graduate_application.pdf** (where Lastname is the applicant's last name);
- Official transcript of all previous university education that includes completed courses through Fall 2019. If you have transferred or are transferring from another university to a university in Texas, please provide an official transcript from all non-Texas institutions previously attended. **Applicants must scan all official transcripts, and submit them in a single pdf file.** The pdf file must be named **Lastname_transcripts.pdf**;
- Scanned copy of GRE scores included in a single pdf file named **Lastname_GRE_score.pdf**; and
- Three letters of recommendation (reference providers must send letters directly to scholarship@awma-gcc.org with email subject **2020 Graduate Scholarship Reference Letter: Lastname**).

Deadline:

A completed application package is due on Tuesday, May 15, 2020. An application package that does not contain all four items specified above by the deadline will be considered incomplete. Email attachment that that did not match any of the filenames expected from applicant will not be opened and processed. **Incomplete application package will not be processed.**

How to apply:

The completed application package should be submitted electronically to: scholarship@awma-gcc.org. The subject of the email must be **2020 Graduate Scholarship Application: Lastname**.
