Air & Waste Management Association (A&WMA) Gulf Coast Chapter Undergraduate Environmental Science and Engineering Scholarship

Application for Entering, Currently Enrolled, and Transfer Students

A&WMA is an independent, non-profit organization that raises and manages private gifts to benefit and promote environmental studies.

A&WMA Gulf Coast Chapter Undergraduate Environmental Science and Engineering Scholarship was created to provide scholarships to undergraduate students who are interested in pursuing a career in an environmental engineering, environmental science, or a related field.

Eligibility

All undergraduate students admitted to a university in the State of Texas, who maintain satisfactory academic progress, and pursue a degree toward Environmental Engineering, Environmental Science, or a related degree are eligible.

Selection Criteria

All of the following selection criteria must be met to be considered by A&WMA:

- Student Major must be Environmental Engineering, Science, Geology, Chemistry, or another environmental related major;
- Student must be enrolling as a new student, current student, or transfer student in the Fall of 2020;
- Student must have a minimum ACT score of 23 or SAT score of 1150;
- Student must be enrolled/enrolling for a minimum of 12 hours and maintain this fulltime status throughout the semester and subsequent semesters;
- The cumulative grade point average (GPA) for current students and transfer students must be at least 3.00 or higher;
- Student must demonstrate leadership potential and participation in student and/or civic organizations and take an active role in their communities;
- Student must have an interest in pursuing a career in the environmental science or related field.



Application Procedure

Application Package:

Application package for Undergraduate Students must include:

- A completed application form, signed, and dated. The form must be named **Lastname_undergraduate_application.pdf** (where Lastname is the applicant's last name);
- Scanned copy of ACT and/or SAT score(s) included in a single pdf file named **Lastname_SAT-ACT_score.pdf**; and
- Official transcripts: Applicants must scan all official transcripts, and submit them in a single pdf file. The pdf file must be named **Lastname_transcripts.pdf**
 - **Incoming Freshmen Only:** An official high school transcript that includes completed courses through Fall 2019;
 - **Currently Enrolled Students (excluding incoming freshmen):** An official university transcript that includes completed courses through Fall 2019. If you have transferred or are transferring more than 15 semester hours to the university, please provide an official transcript from all institutions previously attended.

Deadline:

A completed application package is due on Tuesday, May 15, 2020. An application package that does not contain all three items specified above by the deadline will be considered incomplete. Email attachment that that did not match any of the filenames expected from applicant will not be opened and processed. **Incomplete application package will not be processed.**

The completed application package should be submitted electronically to: scholarship@awma-gcc.org. The subject of the email must be **2020 Undergraduate Scholarship Application: Lastname**.
