Air & Waste Management Association (A&WMA) Gulf Coast Chapter Graduate Environmental Science and Engineering Scholarship

Application for Entering, Currently Enrolled, and Transfer Graduate Students

A&WMA is an independent, non-profit organization that raises and manages private gifts to benefit and promote environmental studies.

A&WMA Gulf Coast Chapter Graduate Environmental Science and Engineering Scholarship was created to provide scholarships to Graduate students who are interested in pursuing a career in an environmental engineering, environmental science, or a related field.

Eligibility

All graduate students admitted to a college or university in the State of Texas, who maintain satisfactory academic and research progress, and pursue a degree toward Environmental Engineering, Environmental Science, or a related degree in the Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) disciplines are eligible.

Selection Criteria

All of the following selection criteria must be met to be considered by A&WMA:

- Student Major must be Environmental Engineering, Environmental Science, or other STEM disciplines that are connected to the environmental field;
- Student must be enrolling as a new student, or enrolled as current student or transfer student in the Fall of 2021;
- Student must have taken the GRE or an equivalent exam;
- Student must be enrolled/enrolling for a minimum of 9 hours and maintain this fulltime status throughout the semester and subsequent semesters;
- The cumulative grade point average (GPA) for current students and transfer students must be at least 3.00;
- Student must demonstrate leadership and participation in student, civic or professional organizations, and take an active role in their communities; and
- Student must have an interest in pursuing a career in the environmental engineering and science or related field.



Membership Expectation

All successful candidates that are awarded scholarship are expected to become A&WMA Gulf Coast Chapter Student Member. The annual membership fee of \$21 will be automatically deducted from the amount awarded. Submitting an application is a confirmation of your agreement to this expectation. Additionally, upon your acceptance of the award, the organization will expect participation in at least one event, e.g. the monthly luncheon or the Annual Conference and Exhibition (ACE).

Application Procedure

Application Package:

Application package for Graduate Students must include:

- A completed application form, signed, and dated. The form must be named **Lastname_graduate_application.pdf** (where Lastname is the applicant's last name);
- Official transcript of all previous university education that includes completed courses through Fall 2020. If you have transferred or are transferring from another university to a university in Texas, please provide an official transcript from all non-Texas institutions previously attended. **Applicants must scan all official transcripts, and submit them in a single pdf file.** The pdf file must be named **Lastname_transcripts.pdf**;
- A copy of GRE scores included in a single pdf file named **Lastname_GRE_score.pdf**; and
- Three letters of recommendation (reference providers must send letters directly to scholarship@awma-gcc.org with email subject **2021 Graduate Scholarship Reference Letter: Lastname**).

Deadline:

A completed application package is due on Tuesday, May 15, 2021. An application package that does not contain all four items specified above by the deadline, and whose filenames does not match the filenames expected from applicants will be considered incomplete. **Incomplete application package will not be processed.**
